"Precision cancer prevention & polygenic risk scores: where we are, what's next?"

Dr. Peeter Padrik is a medical oncologist, researcher, and healthcare entrepreneur. He is the previous Director of the Cancer Centre and Head of Hematology & Oncology Clinic at Tartu University Hospital and now works as an Associate Professor of Oncology at University of Tartu and a medical oncologist in Tartu University Hospital. Dr. Padrik is a pioneer in bringing polygenic risk score technology into healthcare, previously leading national clinical projects in this field. He currently serves as the CEO of Antegenes, a spin-off company from University of Tartu involved in developing polygenic risk scores and implementing them in clinical practice.

"BNCT: past, present and future"

Hanna Koivunoro has been working on Boron Neutron Capture Therapy (BNCT) research and development over her entire career, starting while a student at University of Helsinki, Finland. As the medical physicist, she was closely involved in the BNCT phase I/II clinical trials that were conducted at Helsinki University Central Hospital. Her research interests include neutron dose calculation, dosimetry, and analysis of existing biological dose calculation models against patient responses. During the past five years, Hanna has acted as a chief medical physicist at Neutron Therapeutics Inc., overseeing the creation and integration of the patient-facing aspects of the neutron therapy suite.
