

Survey : Mapping best practices in term of Patient Involvement and collaborations with Patient Organizations in OECI centres


May 2018 – 59 responders

Response rate : All members n = 76: 78%

Full members n = 61: 87%

Associate members n = 15: 40%





81% of OECI cancer centres involved patients in the design of services or the improvement of research

Only 2 CC had no plan to involve patients in the future








Results of Survey 2018





OECI Model of Patient Involvement 2017




Conceptual framework for successfull collaborations between individuals and organisations in CC
