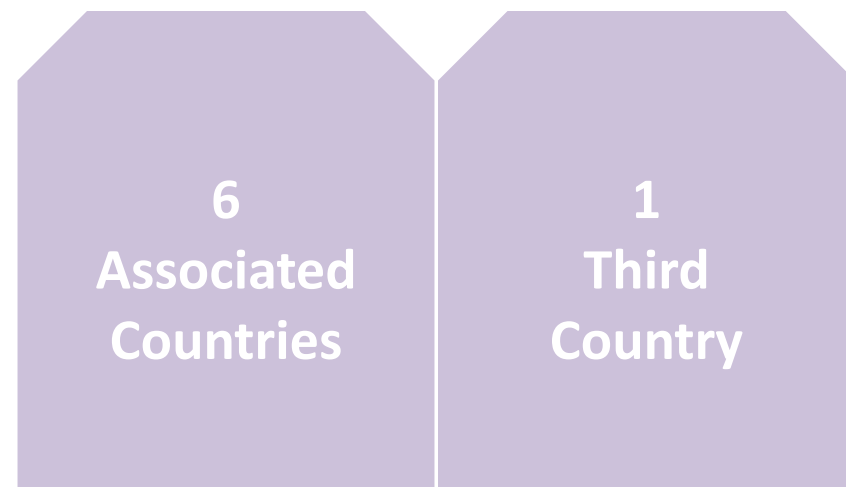
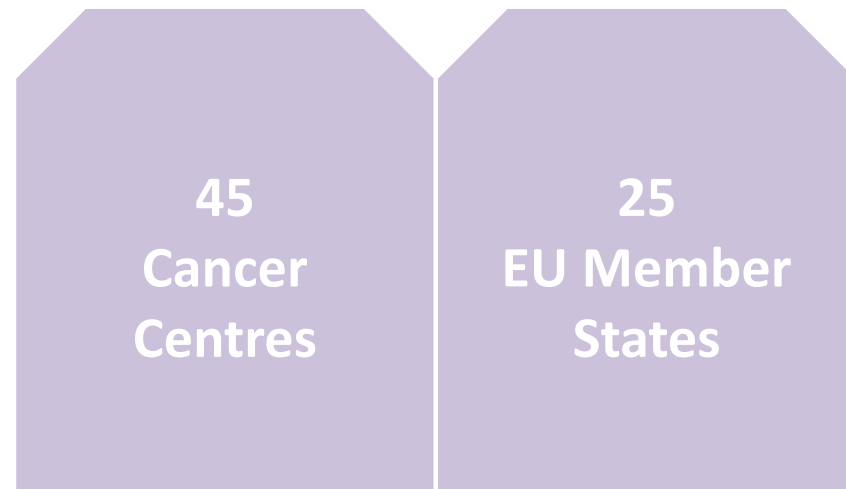
Several cancer centres/institutes from different European countries are involved in the study for the validation of the European Oncology Quality of Life Toolkit.
