Dr Delia Nicoară is a Public Health and Management Specialist at the Oncology Institute “Prof. Dr. Ion Chiricuță” in Cluj-Napoca, the Project Leader on behalf of the institute for the Joint Action on Networks of Expertise (JANE) – WP: Personalized Primary Prevention and TTF2: EU Networking and Member States, the Project Manager for Evaluation on the Joint Action- Network of Comprehensive Cancer Centers: Preparatory activities on creation of National Comprehensive Cancer Centers and EU Networking, the hospital’s EU Project Manager for the Digital TRANSition and Digital resilience in Oncology (TRANSITION) Project and the Project Lead for Policy actions on SUNRISE (SUstainable inteRventions and healthy behaviours for adoleScent primary prevention).

Dr Nicoară is also the Chairperson of the OECD Working Group EPIC-CARE, founding member of the first national cancer consortium in Romania and the public health specialist coordinating prevention and screening in the first national cancer plan in Romania. She is also ISQua certified and participates in the ISQua Fellowship Programme.

Dr Nicoară is involved in the implementation of a Quality Management System and the development of prevention, screening and research standards at the Oncology Institute “Prof. Dr. Ion Chiricuță” in Cluj-Napoca, Romania. She played as well a key role in the development of the National Cancer Competence Centre (NCCP) and the National Cancer Control Plan in Romania.

Her main fields of interest are personalized prevention, policy, screening, reducing inequalities and innovative ways to integrate patient organizations into hospitals activities.

Dr Nicoară will be part of the lead group in several major projects, including the future Joint Action on Comprehensive Cancer Centers (EUNetCCC), as co-lead for the Network Activities and for the implementation phase of the Joint Action on Networks of Expertise (JANE2) as Lead for Personalized Primary Prevention and Screening.
