

## **Per Anders Sandström**

Per Sandström has dedicated his medical career to cancer patients, with the focus on liver, biliary and pancreatic cancers, and metastatic colorectal cancer.

He has always been interested in structure and control of the clinical work processes and the outcome of treatments.

Per Sandström is the Medical Director of Linköping University Hospital, Linköping Sweden (2022).

He is also a professor of surgery at Linköping university (2016). He is Medical Doctor (1992), with a post-doctoral degree in surgery (2000) and PhD in surgery in (2004). He has been the research lead and part of the steering group building the national liver and bile duct cancer registry (SweLiv) from 2008 and onwards, including national guidelines and patients' pathways for the same diseases.

He is also running a national education program for sub specialization in upper GI surgery with members from 2 other Swedish universities.

He is also part of 2 international cancer research networks for liver and pancreatic cancer.

His major areas of expertise and interest are: - Liver, bile duct and pancreatic cancer and metastatic colorectal cancer research, both cancer biology and treatment developments including minimally invasive surgery and robotics as well as methodological development of liver expansion. - Education and health promotion research and programs. He published more than 140 papers in national and international journals, more than 8600 citations. The H.-Index from Scopus (2024) is 33.
